

Quarter 1

July – September 2017

- Integrity Housing and Jamboree Housing are working with UC Irvine and Cal State Fullerton to prepare a meta-analysis into the projected gap in senior housing across all socio-economic factors.
- Draft Scope
 - Current OC population 65+ (if possible what % are homeless)
 - Current housing and demand for independent, assisted, memory care, board and care, skilled nursing, etc.
 - What is the current income level, and what level of governmental assistance is provided at above ages?
 - What are the projections through 2030?

Quarter 2

October – December 2017

Quarter 3

January – March 2018
